The lapel pin is presented to students by the dean of their academic college, according to Jill Alligier, EKU



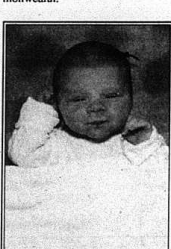
Vanessa Mink, daughter of Lanny Mink of Mt. Vernon, was included on the Dean's Honor List for Spring Term 2000 at Berea College.

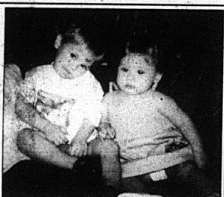
registrar. "Achieving the Dean's List three times is a significant accomplishment," she said.

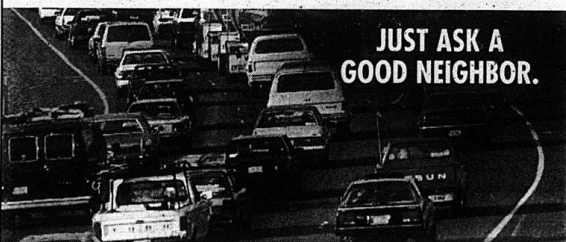
