"THERE is no battleship in the United States Navy that would fill and sink in one hour because of the damage done by three twelve-inch shells on her water line armor, no matter whether they made a gateway or holes as big as a door," declares Rear Admiral Robley D. Evans replying in Hampton's Magazine for February to critics of American battleship construction.

NEWS ITEMS
Senator Tillman has received many congratulations from South Carolina on his speech replying to the President's letter to Senator Hale.

The State-wide prohibition bill passed the Tennessee Senate Monday by a vote of 21 to 12. The House is expected to pass the bill today.

The Illinois Senate has decided to hold a joint session with the House for the purpose of canvassing the vote at the last State election.

George C. Perkins was re-elected United States Senator from California on the first ballot at Sacramento by a vote of 46 to 23 in the Assembly and 33 to 8 in the Senate.

Bundles of switches and threatening notes left on the doorsteps of Jeffersonville residents, while they are thought to have been the work of boys, have aroused some apprehension.

Turkey has decided to accept America's offer of cash assistance for the construction of a canal in Honduras. This election is believed to have eliminated any possibility of war.

Secretary Root and Ambassador Bryce, of Great Britain, at 8 o'clock last night signed a treaty for the settlement of differences between the United States and Canada, popularly known as the Waterways Treaty.

Seventy new cases of Asiatic cholera have been reported in St. Petersburg during the three days following the Russian Christmas. Up to the present time the epidemic shows a total of more than 9,000 cases and 3,599 deaths.

Information was received by telephone this morning from Dunn Hill, Casey county, that George Cudiff, a well-to-do farmer, was attracted to his barn during the night by a rumbling noise. Taking his shotgun in hand, he proceeded to the scene and was fired upon but the party who did the firing took to his heels and discovered the man leading his wagon from the crib. Cudiff took a shot at him and is alleged to have killed George Berry's face with shot. Berry was arrested and his examining trial will take place tomorrow before Magistrate Shelton.

The extreme sensitiveness of the existing relations between the Chief Executive and Congress and the likelihood of further occurrences tending to accentuate the situation will focus wide attention upon the sessions of both Houses during this week. Senator Tillman's speech today, making reply to the charges brought against him in the President's latest special message, is not expected to give rise to the discussion of the official membership of the Capitol. Senator Tillman will take the floor immediately after the Senate convenes today and will make reply in detail to the various allegations contained in the President's letter to Senator Hale. He will not speak at great length and it is not anticipated that action will reply to him.

The bill to prohibit the sale of intoxicating liquor in Tennessee passed the lower house of the General Assembly. The vote was 62 to 36. The Governor is allowed to hold a bill five days. If at the expiration of this time it has not been returned to the Assembly it becomes a law without his signature. State-widers maintain that the Governor's action is not material, that it will be disapproved if his veto will not be sustained. The bill provides that prohibition become effective July 1, 1909.

The late of Judge Booe, we are sure, worries us more than it does him. To think that a man who but a few months ago enjoyed the highest respect of the community, in lodge, in church and in every gelation, should now be clothed in a convict's garb and the occupant of a felon's cell, stirs every feeling of our nature. That a man so trusted should prove so recalcitrant to every trust almost makes one lose confidence in his kid and leaves him ready to say that there are few who can be trusted. That Judge Booe were the lively of heaven the better to conceal his nature of wolf and the easier to work his scheme of theft, but adds to his disgrace. It is not, however, a new one. Bad men have it in all ages.—State Journal.
