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CLIMATE AN ASSET.

In telling the resources of the South, but little has been said hitherto about its climate. All the world knows something of its corn and cotton and tobacco, and since the war something, though not published about its mineral wealth and the means at hand to develop it. One exceptional asset meanwhile has been practically ignored, namely, its wonderful climate.

The value of a superb climate and what it may do for a locality stands confessed in the story of the South of France and of California. It used to be said of Southern California that it had nothing but its climate, and at the time it was said this was largely true. But Southern California to-day is the richest region of all America, if not in all the world. Its climate attracted to it those who were in quest of health and wealth, with resulting luxury and development.

Experts now tell us that the famed salubrious climate of California is exactly duplicated in Georgia and Alabama, that there is no difference between the two, and that the time is not distant when this fact will be known and appreciated. Granted that such is now the case, then the South has most easily the advantage. It is a long journey from New York to Los Angeles even under the best conditions. But from New York to Augusta and Mobile by rail is a trip accomplishable within a few hours, while by water it is a cruise of a like number of days. It is said that the wealth of Georgia has not an end of places in brief voyages to the Bermudas, and that the number of cruises to those islands in quest of recreation or health is steadily increasing. When these two outlets for developing the States of Georgia and Alabama as health and pleasure resorts have been carried out, such voyagers, no doubt, will be extended further on the South Atlantic coast what they had supposed could only be known in California. Plans are being pushed to build great and luxurious hotels along the South Atlantic coast, so that wealth may find there what it is willing to pay for handsomely elsewhere. These resorts are to be connected by well kept public roads, over which automobiles may be driven with safety. And speedily the South may wake up to find its climate an asset and source of revenue, not one which behind its assets of corn and cotton and tobacco.

JUDGE BETHURM MAKES POWERFUL APPEAL FOR MOB PREVENTION (Extracts of address before Circuit Judges meeting held in Louisville the last of December.) Speaking upon the subject of "How the Mob is Prevented or Punished by the State," Judge R. F. Bethurm of Somerset discussed practically every phrase of the question, and his words were loudly applauded by members of the Kentucky Circuit Judges Association. The address is as follows: "This association of circuit judges has met frequently called by me, and with able address delivered by men of great power and ability at former meetings, but I must say that the subject discussed upon these occasions although of great importance to the people generally, furnishing food for the deeper thought, and the discussion of which so long a period of time has been devoted to it, has not been given the attention it deserves."

How has ever had before it a subject of such universal and widespread interest, of such profound importance, as the subject of "How the Mob is Prevented or Punished by the State?"

HARD QUESTION TO ANSWER. That is a question to which it is very difficult to give a satisfactory answer. Men trained in the science of the law and of statesmanship have been confronted with this question since the very dawn of civilization, and have been endeavoring to formulate or originate some method whereby the mob may be prevented and the law of the land allowed to take its due course in the regulation of society and in the punishment of crime, but it seems, that notwithstanding the fact that men of towering genius, great leaders and civil rulers, have spent ages in this noble undertaking, yet the fact remains that the question is no more nearly answered today than it was a thousand years ago. It is a matter which has been considered, but what I may offer in this connection will not furnish a genuine correct solution of the question that will set it to the satisfaction of all.

"But while it may be utterly impossible to prevent the formation of the mob, yet I am a firm believer in the doctrine of the ultimate triumph of the right, and in the end the certain and complete overthrow of the wrong, and while it may be difficult to so control society as that the mob will be entirely eliminated, yet I feel absolutely certain that by the application of the proper means it is possible to practically weed it out from amongst us, and substitute therefor law and order. To do this requires great patience."

EDUCATION IS REMEDY. In the first place, I take it to be the duty of every citizen to see that the people and meaning of the law, its broadness and scope, should be thoroughly educated. I believe that no wicked, lawless, or violent man ever hatched in the heart of a thoroughly educated, civilized and cultured people. It does not mean to say (and it does not mean to be understood) that the illiterate and illiterate of the land constitute the lawless masses. There are many millions of struggling, honest people who have a high regard for the law, as far as they understand it, and for which they live, as many of the noble gentlemen who have attained to the highest standards of moral excellence, but it cannot be denied that education—the broadening of the intellectual horizon—is the first and best way to implant in the human mind and breast the proper respect for the law and its orderly enforcement. This is but natural. The better development of the mind, the more we search into the unfathomed depths of the sciences and the arts, the more we read of the philosopher and law givers, and of their productions, the more we learn of our great achievements of representative government—the wonder and marvel of the world—the more we reason and think, the better equipped we are for citizenship; and when a criminal approaches a person thus enlightened and equipped with a suggestion that he commit a crime or do some sort of violence, the developed and trained mind and judgment appraises the suggestion. But the man surrounded by the impenetrable darkness of illiteracy and ignorance, with a skull as thick as a stone, whose eye never gaze upon the torch of reason, will with little persuasion join the mob determined to do blood-thirsty work.
