Ordinance No. 203

An Ordinance relating to traffic and regulating the use of public streets and highways in the City of Mount Vernon, Kentucky... prescribing regulations relating to the parking of vehicles upon such streets and highways...

WHEREAS, the traffic conditions which have existed for a long period of time in certain sections of the City of Mount Vernon, Kentucky, have impeded the free movement of traffic...

WHEREAS, attempts to regulate traffic and parking have not been as successful as desired... the habit of various operators of motor vehicles of parking for long periods of time in close proximity to other motor vehicles on the most congested portions of the city's business streets...

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the City Council of the City of Mount Vernon, that the method by which such conditions may be remedied is by the designation of parking spaces in the hereinafter provided areas by the use of mechanical parking time indicators in conjunction therewith...

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Mt. Vernon, Kentucky, does ordain as follows: Section 1. For the purpose of this ordinance, the word "vehicle" shall mean any device in or upon which any person or property is or may be transported upon a highway or street...

Section 2. There are hereby established and fixed certain zones to be known as parking meter zones in and on the following streets and highways in the City of Mount Vernon, Kentucky: First Street between Main Street and the railroad crossing on West Main Street...

Section 3. When a parking space in any parking meter zone is available for use, such parking space shall be marked with a sign which shall be placed on the front of such vehicle...

Section 4. The payment for such meters and for the installation thereof shall be provided solely for the receipts, funds, and revenues obtained from the operation of said parking meters without in any manner obligating the City of Mount Vernon to pay for any portion of such costs...

Section 5. The Chief of Police shall have lines or markings painted or placed upon the curb or upon the street adjacent to each parking meter or the purpose of designating the parking space for which said meter is to be used...

Section 17. The police officer shall place upon each such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator that such vehicle has been or is to be reported to the Chief of Police...

Section 18. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to the penalties hereinafter provided...
