



## ECONOMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Several million young people are now wondering just what influence the pending preparedness program will have on their personal destinies. An exact answer now is impressible but the trend of Congressional thinking is becoming clearer. The United States News recently published an excellent summing up of which is not be on to nappen.

First of all, the prospects for universal military train-

now are exceedingly dim. The idea of it goes against the grain of national sentiment and, from a purely political point of view, it is considered too hot to handle in an elec-

On the other hand, a limited draft has a better than even chance of getting by Congress. The armed forces have made a good case of their need for manpower, and Congress seems to be reluctantly coming to the conclusion that at temporary return to selective service is unavoidable.

If the draft law is passed, it will probably call for two years of service for those chosen. During the coming year, the forces will need about 900,000 men, to whom 720,000 will go to the Army. It is believed that voluntary enlist-mens will account for all but 220,000 of that number. That means that out but of each six young men who are eligible for selection will go into uniform

The pending law will probably demand the registration of all men from the ages of 18 through 30. However, only those in the 19-25 age group will be called to the color. at this time. And a great many ofthese will be exempt. The exemptions will include veterans of World War II, if the saw a year or more of service, and high school students. It is expected that married men and industrial workers with important skills and trades will be at least temporarily deferred by local draft boards, even though the law does not specifically exempt them from the draft. And physical qualifications will be substantially higher than they were in wartime when, as the saying went, anyone who could chew mush, see lightening and hear thunder was consider-

ed grist for the military mill.

There serves, both commissioned and chilisted will be asked to volunteer for asserting to volunteer for service, and a good many of them. will be needed to train the new draftees. However, it is unlikely that those who do not volunteer will be ordered back into service. One rather curious anomoly exists here. Under the law, the Army reserves cannot be ordeed to active duty. for more than two weeks a year unless Congress declares a state of emergency. This is also true of the Air Force and
