

Appropriations of \$112,571 to common school purposes during the coming two-year fiscal period was promised by Gov. A. B. Chandler, "in order to make the Foundation Program fully operative."

"We intend to check ingofar as posible this unnecessary exdus of trained teachers from Kentucky," s a i d Governor Changler. "Its. our purpose to meet in full Kentucky's obligation to public education and fully implement the Foundation Programs which means so much to the welfare of all our people."

The Governor's recommenda-tions will include \$54,785,500 for public elementary and high schools for the first year of the coming two-year budget period, and \$57,785,500 for the second year-an_increase of \$43,000, 000 for the period.

Most of the increase will go to teachers' salaries to be fixed in accordance with standards in the Foundation Law the recommendations compare with officials requests of \$57, 473.547 and \$82.247.07% for each year, but these were trimmed to take care of actual class room units in use, rather than potential units.
