

(2) Name one lake in the nation where the area below a dam has been built up and promoted successfully for recreation or any other purpose.

Corps of Engineers officials and state officials, in answer to the question, say it is very likely. To the statement, they say it has considerable accuracy.

Everyone agrees these things should be studied closely before opposition openly develops, especially in Rockeastle County.

If a dam at the Narrows backs water only to Route 80 then it would obviously be of no value to Rockeastle, since it would not border on the county. If it backs water 30 feet under the bridge at Fort Sequoyah, and to lesser depths above, then perhaps the county would have a lake of more value than it now realized.
