NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. VERNON, KENTUCKY, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Definitions. As used in this Ordinance the following terms have the following respective mean-ings unless the context indicates or requires otherwise:

(d) The sewer system is "available" as that term is used in this Ordinance to any premises in the City while abut upon any street, road, alley, public way or easument it which there exists a sewer pipe, main, lateral or other structure or installation of the sewer system capable or receiving flowable wastes in which the City has brought a sewer like to a point located at the edge of the property line or easement of the owner of such premises.

Section 14. All ordinances, orders, resolutions, mo-tions, or parts thereof, insofar as same may be in conflict herewith, are repealed, and this Ordinance shall taken effect from and after its adoption, approval, and publication as provided by law.


