Hospital renovation, Department of Child Welfare for child welfare facilities, Department of Health for county health centers, Health Services Building addition, Department of Corrections, Department of Agriculture for animal disease diagnostic laboratory, State Fair Board and Murray State College for livestock sales and exhibition facilities, Department of Conservation for small lakes, Department of Conservation for forestry facilities, Department of Parks, Department of Aeronautics for airport facilities, Department of Public Safety for state police barracks?
